Horizontal Directional Drilling Construction Inspector

The Horizontal Directional Drilling Inspector is the individual who is accountable for the safe, reliable, timely and cost efficient execution of the construction component of the overall project.

Inspectors will be representing major oil and gas industry clients on HDD construction projects and will ensure quality and integrity of the project and document work activities; i.e. take measurements and photographs, as needed. In addition, Inspectors will be required to provide the following services/oversight and certifications to the client:

Duties/Responsibilities:

- Monitor contractor quality, safety procedures and productivity
- Report and record a day-to-day account of the entire construction of the project
- Monitor and report drilling fluid volume balance, drilling fluid parameters, drilling fluid additives
- Monitor and report annular pressure data
- Report and record turbidity results
- Inspect materials and quality of work of drilling operations for conformance to specifications
- Drilling and Steering Data Tracking
- Advise supervisor regarding corrections to be made
- Monitor and report surface activities, pull force and inadvertent returns
- Monitor contractor activities to ensure regulatory agency participation in ongoing construction activities as Acts or Regulations may dictate
- Document and sign-off on all compliance requirements
- Participate in contractor progress review meetings
- Monitor and report on contractor adherence to schedule
- Cost tracking procedures
- Monitor contractor'(s) compliance with respect to quality of work and adherence to applicable codes, standards, design documents and schedules
- Monitor contractor quality, safety procedures and productivity
