Pipeline Construction Inspector Trainee

The Pipeline Inspector Trainee is the individual who will assist the Construction Inspector for being accountable for the safe, reliable, timely and cost efficient execution of the construction component of their portion of the project. Trainees will assist the Construction Inspector when representing major oil and gas industry clients on construction, maintenance, and/or abandonment projects. Trainees & Inspectors will be used to ensure quality and integrity of the project and to document work activities; i.e. take measurements and photographs, as needed. In addition, Trainees will be required to provide the following services/oversight and certifications to the Construction Inspector/Mentor:

Trainees will assist the general Inspector with the following Duties/Responsibilities:

- Monitor contractor quality, safety procedures and productivity
- Inspect materials and quality of work of pipeline construction for conformance to specifications
- Observe preparation of right-of-way for conformance to contract agreement
- Verify depth and alignment of trenches
- Examine bottom of trench for rocks or other hard objects that might damage pipe coatings
- Examine surface and x-ray films of welded joints to detect external and internal welding defects
- Observe coating and wrapping of pipe or pipe joints for conformance to specifications and verify accuracy of coating by observing or conducting electrical tests for holidays (inadequately coated areas on pipe)
- Advise supervisor regarding corrections to be made
- Monitor contractor activities to ensure regulatory agency participation in ongoing construction activities as Acts or Regulations may dictate
- Document and sign-off on all compliance requirements
- Preparation of daily field reports and related documentation
- Participate in contractor progress review meetings
- Monitor and report on contractor adherence to schedule
- Monitor contractor'(s) compliance with respect to quality of work and adherence to applicable codes, standards, design documents and schedules

Qualifications:

- Ability to familiarize with the application of the processes dictated by the quality manual and safety procedures
- Prefer a minimum of 3 years experience working on pipeline construction projects
- Ability to work in a team environment
- Willing to work long hours in the field and in harsh environments
- Willing to train in Microsoft Word Level 1, Excel Level 1 and other advancement programs
